A few notes on living Tiny – please read!

Getting used to the space take it slowly and adjust to the unusual shape of your new home, especially on the mezzanine levels. You may not be used to sloping / low ceilings, and of course ladders!

Power is solar power and 12 volt. There are USB charger sockets for phones and laptops (NB older laptops will drain a lot of power – best to charge in The Studio)

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO BE SPARING WITH POWER USAGE

You are very welcome at any time to use the STUDIO for charging and the WIFI. Please use the hand sanitiser by the door.

There is also a hairdryer and an iron available for your use.

Please sanitise before and after use with paper towel and gel from the dispenser provided

The KEYSAFE CODE FOR THE STUDIO is PROVIDED IN YOUR TINY HOME

The Toilet is a composting toilet – please follow the instructions in the bathroom on how to use it.

Feel free to use the provided sawdust for aesthetic purposes and, if you need, put the fan on – white switch next to the toilet – DO NOT leave this running constantly as it uses the precious solar energy! Most especially **do not** leave the fan running all night!

If you need the toilet serviced (emptied) during your stay this is no problem. Please let us know before midday – text 07802758113 , and then follow the directions as shown in the video to remove the bucket and leave outside. We now ask you to do this because it is best we do not come into the cabin when you are in residence unless it is unavoidable. **You DO NOT need to take the bucket out when you check out.**

Water and our reed beds – we need to imagine we are somewhere where water is more **precious**. Use sparingly and be mindful of what you put down the plugholes! Coffee grounds and cooking fats etc **must** be disposed of mindfully and **NEVER** down the sink or it will ruin the bio system of the reed bed!

What we have provided to manage cooking fats etc:

- disposable silver sheets that you can put in grill trays and the like
- kitchen roll – to mop out frying pans
- Special fat disposal container – for pourable fats and oils

Your use of environmentally friendly health and beauty products where possible is appreciated .

The Meadow

At present the meadow is in its natural state and children are welcome to explore – with your supervision. There is a teeny-tiny playhouse. Please be understanding that it is a ‘wild’ area and should be approached as such!

Rubbish and recycling

There are main bins at the car park area.

Mixed recycling and general waste.

Food waste for composting – wrapped or bagged and in the bin please

FUEL

Logs are stored in the bins next to the car park – help yourself

NB – you will see we have a log store next to the caravan – PLEASE NOTE these logs are not yet seasoned so no good to use yet!

Tiny living in more detail

The kitchen

- Again, no grease, fat, coffee grounds etc are to be put down the plughole!
- The bins are under the sink area – you will be able to separate your waste.
- There is an extractor fan to use while you cook – please remember to switch it off to save power.

The living space

Bed linen for the sofa beds is stored on the ground floor – in bags, baskets or lockers under sofas

The Nook (Tiny Homes Eilidh and Hygge)

- Storage area / futon space
- Accessed by loft ladder that you pull down with the hook pole provided
- Adults only to use

The Bathroom

Toilet instructions are on the toilet wall.

We service the toilets for you but at the current time we ask you to remove the waste bucket and place outside to enable social distancing – please have a look at the online video

Just let us know when you would like it emptied – as often as you like and no trouble at all but please let us know **in the morning** Text 07802758113

Please be mindful of water usage when showering.

Sleeping mezzanine

A small tray is provided if you wish to take drinks etc upstairs – be careful on that ladder!

Outside space

Be mindful of the edge of the decking with regards to chairs!

BBQ – **must** be used on the slabbed area to the side of the Tiny... please do not use on the deck or in the meadow as it is a fire risk. Seriously.

It is important that you read and honour the guest protocols that you have agreed to as we reopen post Covid-19 – we can't thank you enough for your help with this.
